Intended Use: This device is used as an aid for detecting germline BRCA1 or BRCA2 gene mutations in genomic DNA extracted from whole blood and for determining the eligibility of patients with breast, ovarian, pancreatic, or prostate cancer for olaparib treatment or patients with breast cancer for TumorX[®] (olaparib) treatment.
This device is also used to identify individuals with a high risk of BRCA-Related Breast and/or Ovarian Cancer (BROOC) Syndrome and may be used as an aid for informing medical management decisions.

The majority of deleterious or suspected deleterious mutations identified by Myriad in BRCA1 and BRCA2 are classified using objective criteria based on the type and genomic position of the variants. Other deleterious or suspected deleterious mutations may be classified by other criteria that are based on available evidence. The classification and interpretation of all variants identified in this assay reflect the current state of Myriad's scientific understanding at the time this report was issued. Variant classification and interpretation may change for a variety of reasons, including but not limited to, improvements to classification techniques, availability of additional scientific information, and observation of a variant in more patients.
